Policy for ensuring Impartiality

1 October 2022

Nippon Kaiji Kyokai ensures impartiality in providing EU MRV and UK MRV certification services. Risks that are related to impartiality arising from the provision of the certification services are constantly monitored, identified and addressed in line with the current situation, and managed with due care. We also understand the importance of impartiality in the implementation of validation and verification activities, managing conflicts of interest and the need of ensuring compliance with objectives.

We will not tolerate commercial, financial or other pressures that undermine impartiality and will not provide certification if our relationships with others pose an unacceptable threat to impartiality.

To further ensure impartiality, an Impartiality Committee, mainly composed of external stakeholders, is established to consult on issues affecting impartiality, including transparency and public perception of the certification activities, and to seek advice on these issues, which is then reflected in the certification activities.

We will ensure that all personnel involved in EU MRV and UK MRV certification activities understand the importance of impartiality and ensure objectivity.
