MARITIME CYBER RISK MANAGEMENT IN SAFETY

MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS

In the interest of the service and in order to raise awareness on cyber risk threats and vulnerabilities to support safe and secure shipping pursuant to the International Maritime Organization (IMO) issuance of Resolution MSC.428(98) adopted on 16 June 2017 (MSC 98/23/Add.1 Annex 10, page 1), all shipping companies with Philippine registered ships certified under the International Safety Management (ISM) Code are required to take into account cyber risk management in their safety management system.

The functional elements that support effective cyber risk management shall be included in the safety management system and subject to audit no later than the first annual verification of the company's Document of Compliance after 01 January 2021.
