

INFORMATION BULLETIN No. 74

Ship Security Alert System

Having reference to SOLAS Chapter XI-2 Regulation 6. 2. 1, the ship to shore Alert required by this regulation is required to be transmitted to a competent authority as designated by the Administration, which may include the Company, defined as the owner, manager or bareboat charterer. (see SOLAS Ref. Ch. IX Reg.1.2).

In cases where a ‘tracking service provider’ shall be the direct recipient receiving the initial ship to shore alert the company may register more than one contact point to receive the forwarded alert.

Where multiple contact points are registered it shall be designated which contact point has the responsibility for action and which contact points are for information only.

In this context the contact point designated to act upon receiving an Alert shall have the required 24/7 capability for both receiving such alerts and instigating the appropriate ‘real time reactions’.
