SUBJECT: ISPS ANNUAL SECURITY EXERCISE

The ISPS Code (13.7 of Part B) requires a security exercise to be carried out at least once each calendar year with no more than 18 months between exercises. This exercise is conducted to test the company's communications, co-ordination, resource availability and response.

As per Marine Operations Note 02- 2006 issued by this Administration, ISPS exercise reports are to be sent to the Administration to provide documentary evidence of the exercise. All CSO are reminded to provide a summary of the exercise to the Administration with a copy going to all of the Liberian vessels in his fleet.

The summary is to include a:

- 1. Description of the scenario.
- 2. Summary of the exercise (Time/Date/Location-Participants sequence of major events).
- 3. List of all parties involved.
- 4. Description of any lessons learned that could improve the SSP.
