

Order on financial security for seafarers' repatriation with subsistence¹

The following shall be laid down pursuant to section 10a(3) and section 73a(2) of the act on seafarers' conditions of employment, etc. (*lov om søfarendes ansættelsesforhold m.v.*), cf. consolidated act no. 742 of 18 July 2005, as amended by act no. 493 of 12 May 2010 and act no. 622 of 14 June 2011, and by authority:

Section 1. The shipowner's obligation to provide financial security pursuant to section 73a(1) of the act for repatriation with subsistence for seafarers shall be considered met through the pool established pursuant to section 10a(2) of the act for economic protection of seafarers left behind.

Section 2. This order shall enter into force on 20 August 2013 and shall apply to repatriation commenced after the entry into force.
