## STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE TO DEMONSTRATE MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF ARTICLE 12 OF THE REGULATION (EU) 1257/2013 ON SHIP RECYCLING

We refer to Article 12 of the Regulation (EU) 1257/2013 which states that the Statement of Compliance shall be issued after verification of the inventory of hazardous materials by the relevant authorities of the third country whose flag the ship is flying or an organisation authorised by them, in accordance with the national requirements.

- Please be informed that at this point of time, the national requirement on ship recycling has not been established in Singapore. The Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA) has no objection for the following Classification Societies, who are also our Recognised Organisations to issue the Statement of Compliance for Singapore registered ship to demonstrate meeting the requirements of Regulation (EU) 1257/2013.
