To whom it may concern

The Bahamas Maritime Authority (BMA) has issued Marine Notice 90, which is a notification related to requirements for marine equipment that is required under relevant international conventions and associated codes to be type-approved by Flag State Administrations.

According to the Notice, the "marine equipment" provided on board Bahamian ships is to be any of the followings:

- 1. Equipment certified by other Recognized Organizations (ROs) authorized by the BMA,
- 2. Equipment certified under Directive 2014/90/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council on marine equipment by other ROs authorized by the BMA, or
- 3. Equipment certified by other States that are parties to SOLAS, provided that the approval is in accordance with Convention requirements.
