# NK TECHNICAL INFORMATION

To Shipowners and Shipbuilders concerned

The "Guidelines and Specifications for Pollution Prevention Equipment for Machinery Space Bilges of Ships" (Res. MEPC.60(33)) which supersedes the recommendations contained in resolution A.393(X) were adopted at MEPC 33 held at IMO Headquarters in October 1992 and apply under Annex I of MARPOL 73/78 ;

- (1) to pollution prevention equipment fitted to ships, the keel of which are laid or which are at a similar stage of construction on or after 30 April 1994; and
- (2) to pollution prevention equipment newly fitted on or after 30 April 1994 to ships, the keel of which were laid or which were at a similar stage of construction before 30 April 1994 in so far as is reasonable and practicable.

According to the newly revised Guidelines and Specifications, the above pollution prevention equipment (i.e. oil filtering equipment and oil content meter for the bilge alarms) should be accompanied by a certificate of type approval issued by the Contracting Governments and a copy of the certificates should be carried on board ships.
