To Shipowners and Shipbuilders concerned

This Society has sometimes received inquiries from the shipowners about the Tonnage Certificates of non-Canadian ships entering Canadian ports. According to the Tonnage of Ships Order, 1981 of the Canadian Government issued on 16 July, 1981, the tonnage denoted in the certificates of registry or other national papers of any ships of a country set out below is accepted by the Canadian Government.

For any ships of a country other than the above, re-calculation of the tonnage in accordance with the Canadian tonnage regulations may be required by the Canadian Port Authority when the ships call at Canadian ports.

In this regard, we are pleased to inform you that this Society has been advised by the Canadian Government that the Canadian Port Authority would accept the Appendix Certificate for Canadian Tonnage issued by this Society. The said Appendix Certificate is requested to be attached to the original Tonnage Certificate issued also by this Society.
