Radar To Be Installed
On Board Japanese Ships

To shipowners and shipbuilders concerned,

In the light of the adoption of the resolution MSC.64(67) recommending to amend the performance standards of radar specified in the IMO assembly resolution A.477(XII), the relevant requirements of the Rules for Safety Equipment of the Society are being amended on the basis of the amended performance standards in the Annex to the resolution MSC.64(67).

As a tentative arrangement until such time as the relevant rule requirements are amended, radar to be installed on board a Japanese ship on or after 1 January 1999 should be those inspected/certified in accordance with the relevant national requirements of Japan and amendments thereto (effective 1 January 1999).

It should be noted that the "date when radar are installed on board" means the "date when a provisional radio station license is granted in connection with opening of the radio station, or when a change in the radio installation is granted, under the Radio Law of Japan".
