Lifeboat and Liferaft rations
for Liberian flag ships

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To shipowners and shipbuilders concerned

With regard to the subject matter, the Liberian Government has just informed us of its requirements, which are briefly quoted below for your reference:

1. The Liberian Government has so far required a food ration with an energy value of 4800 Calories (19821 Kilo joules) per person in lifeboats and 2400 Calories (9912 KJ) per person in liferafts.

It is however the new requirement of the Government that a food ration per person in both lifeboats and liferafts may be with an energy value of not less than 10,000 KJ (2400 Calories).

2. The food ration currently being kept onboard may be continuously used, but should be replaced by a ration complying with the above requirement on the expiry of the manufacturer's guarantee period or when the appearance or taste indicates.
