To: Owners of chemical tankers concerned

It is identified as "Vegetable oils (those not otherwise listed)" in the list of products annexed and attached to the Certificate of Fitness for chemical tankers carrying vegetable oils presently issued by this Society according to chapter VII of BCH code or chapter 18 of IBC code.

However, it has been reported that some tankers were in trouble with the port authorities due to no description of an individual name of each vegetable oil when loading/unloading the cargo products.

Accordingly, this Society would recommend you to attach the enclosed "EXPLANATORY NOTE ON VEGETABLE OIL" to a existing Certificate of Fitness held on board the ship concerned to avoid such troubles in future.

An individual name of vegetable oils will be included in the attachment of the Certificate of Fitness to be issued/re-issued hereafter.

NOTE: The above-mentioned is not arranged for Japanese-flag chemical tankers.
